**TRITON 13000/2
TITANIC EXPLORER**
The TRITON 13000/2 Titanic Explorer has an impressive 4,000-metre depth rating and patented Gull Wings for versatile operation and storage. Cameras mounted in the wings can film both around the submersible and inside its cabin. For big fish only. *From £10,500,000, tritonsubs.com*

**SEAMAGINE
AURORA-6**
Seating up to six for sociable exploring, the Aurora-6 has a dive depth of 1,000 metres. The transparent cabin provides unobstructed views and comfort, and a single-point hoist makes for easy launching. *From \$5.5 million, seamagine.com*

**U-BOAT WORX
C-RESEARCHER 3**
With its clear and distortion-free acrylic sphere, the two-person C-Researcher 3 offers deep diving to 1,140 metres. Winner of a Red Dot Design Award, it has a climate control system to keep passengers comfortable, and its tender bumper allows for easy boarding. *From £3,000,000, uboatworx.com*

TRITON 660/9 AVA
This is the first submersible to have a non-spherical acrylic pressure hull and a large interior volume that can be furnished to become anything from a wedding venue to a dining room or casino – as long as the guest list is kept below 10 people. *From £4,000,000, tritonsubs.com*

U-BOAT WORX NEMO
Weighing in at 2,500kg, the Nemo is the lightest manned submersible produced to date – you can even tow it behind your car. With a 100-metre dive capacity, it allows two occupants to explore the undersea world without busting the budget. *From £860,000, uboatworx.com*
