FLY ME TO THE DEEP

Pushing the boundaries of underwater exploration is the cutting-edge Titanic Explorer by Triton Submarines, the company responsible for bringing us much of the incredible deep ocean footage in the documentary *Blue Planet II*. This new personal submersible is the deepest diving acrylic pressure-hulled manned submersible ever produced, capable of reaching a depth of 4,000m. It also features a groundbreaking "Gull Wing" design that provides unrivalled versatility of operation. Retracting the wings streamlines the vehicle for ascent and descent, and manoeuvring in and around incredibly tight spaces. Extended, the wings serve as a platform for lighting and cameras. Named in honour of Triton's first manned mission in August 2019 to visit the RMS Titanic, which has been untouched by man for the past 14 years, this machine now takes the most intrepid of adventurers into the uncharted frontiers of the ocean, of which 80 per cent still remains a mystery.
